

Omri Lulav - Curriculum vitae

Omri Lulav serves as managing director of the National Coal Ash Board (NCAB) since 1995. NCAB is a governmental agency that was established in 1993 by the Ministry of Energy and Infrastructures (known today as the Ministry of Energy and Water), in cooperation with the Ministry of the Environment, the Interior Ministry, the Israel Electric Company (IEC) and the National Coal Supply Company (NCSC), with the objective of coordinating a national effort to solve the problem of ash that is accumulating at the coal-fired power stations.

Omri Lulav studied mathematics (widened scope, including topics from Philosophy, Economics and Business Management) at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. In 1983 – 1995 he served as a Director of the Coal Unit at the Ministry of Energy and Infrastructure and part of this time as a Member of the Boards of Directors of NCSC, IEC and Harbors and Rails Authority.
